

## Pre-requisite Curriculum needed to enter the School of Nursing

Completion of 60 hours with a 3.0 GPA (the courses below comprise these hours)

Certified Nursing Assistant CNA (in some states may be PCT)- This can be taken at a community college, nursing home and in some states at a hospital.

### Courses Needed Prior to Entering the School of Nursing:

#### **Social Science**

- 3 additional hours from the Social Science list of University Requirements (PSYC 120 or EDUC 211 will not fulfill this requirement)
- General Ed 3 hours from anything on the University Requirements
- Elective 3 hours (Medical Terminology recommended)

#### **Physical Education**

- PEAC 100 Lifetime Wellness AND 1 additional PEAC course OR 2 PEAC courses

#### **Communication (Speech)**

- COMS 211 Speech & Rhetoric
- Foreign Language or Cultural Awareness –3 hours from University Requirements (Must have 2 years of Foreign Language in High School, otherwise 6 hours of Foreign Language is Required)
